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Week 6 in K/1



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
Week 6 in 2/3/4

During maths this week we enjoyed a video conference with Cassilis Public School. We were given a task of adding 49 plus 32. The children had to mentally find an answer to this algorithm and explain the method that they used. We shared our responses with each other.
