Mrs Coffey will return to assist with reading groups and continue the gardening program.



#### **Principals Speech 2020 Presentation Night**

When I accepted the position of Relieving Principal on the 9<sup>th</sup> March, I had no idea how much our lives were about to change. COVID was just starting to raise its head and there were whispers of restrictions that could possibly come to into force. I visited Murrurundi on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March to meet with Mrs Coffey and the staff for handover. That night, the NSW Premier released a statement urging all parents to keep their children home from school. Overnight, our schools went from being fully attended thriving learning environments to just a handful of staff and only a few or in some cases no students in attendance.

This bought on a whole new set of challenges for us all. Suddenly parents were juggling work commitments, home duties and home schooling. They were expected to take on the role of teacher and supervise learning through digital platforms, while maintaining their day to day routines. Please put your hands together and say 'thank you' to our parents, who have continued to support the education of our students.

Let's hope that in 2021 we return to some sense of normal, where students can look forward to excursions, sporting opportunities, participating in events with other small schools and visits within the community. Where parents can look forward to attending assemblies, volunteering at the school and holding school functions.
